Sign Up for emails: **what is coming in your order**, many additional special order items, delivery updates and farm news. Email *your name, your coordinator's name* and *what day you pick up* to pdemaillist1@verizon.net.

If you are going to be away on pick up day, please give your coordinator the name & phone number(s) of your sub(s).

This week, we expect NY Ecologically grown *Jonagold apples*, organically grown NC sweet **potatoes**, FL **kale**, CA **broccoli**, *green cabbage*, **carrots**, **cauliflower**, **celery**, **grapefruit** and *green leaf lettuce*, **cherry tomatoes** from Mexico, Peruvian **bananas** and Chilean **blueberries**. Anything else is a **make-up**. Please tell your coordinator *immediately* if you have any quality problems! By law, we only have 24 hours to get supplier credits.

Fruit shares: I am planning to get *Braeburn apples*, *Navel oranges*, **blueberries** and **strawberries**. Fruit shares are \$20 each, 3+, \$17. Order or **CANCEL** by Mon. 9 am (Fri. for Wed. groups)

Dividing instructions are in the manila envelope sent with each delivery. Please be vigilant about quality and *call us right away* so we can get credit from suppliers. **Get an ok from the office if you feel it best not to give out an entire case of something or before you divide two cases of anything if instructions do not say to.**

Some people host for one year; some host for as many as 15 years. Hosting earns a discount and helps support small organic farmers in our region, as well as helping families like yours be able to afford excellent organic food all year.

Roasted Cauliflower: 1 cauliflower washed, florets separated olive oil garlic flakes or powder, salt & pepper Drizzle cauliflower with oil and sprinkle with garlic. Add salt and pepper, if desired. Bake in a 400° oven until tops are browned, about 20 minutes.

Pureed Vegetable Soup: Prep, chop in large chunks and steam 1 broccoli, 1 cauliflower, 1 onion (opt.) and 2 sweet potatoes. Cool. Puree in small batches with the steaming water and return to pot. Add extra stock or water if needed to achieve the desired consistency. Heat and serve with a dollop of yogurt or sour cream in each bowl. Season with tamari and Louisiana hot sauce.
